- 8. A review of the performance of the group, to the extent necessary for a reasonable understanding of the group's business. It must include a discussion of the following:
  - a) Any significant factors that affected the turnover, costs and earnings of the group for the current financial period reported on, including (where applicable) seasonal or cyclical factors.

The Group's revenue for the quarter ended 30 September 2016 ("1Q FY2017") was \$\$13.0 million compared to \$\$14.0 million for the quarter ended 30 September 2015 ("1Q FY2016"). 1Q FY2016 revenue was higher due to the sale of an inventory yacht.

Gross profit came to S\$2.3 million in 1Q FY2017, down from S\$3.4 million in 1Q FY2016 due largely to the lower revenue and the weaker U.S. dollar in 1Q FY2017 as compared to 1Q FY2016. A significant portion of the Group's sales is denominated in U.S. dollars. As a result, gross margin decreased to 17.3% from 24.5% over the comparative periods.

Total operating expenses, which include costs relating to boat shows, selling and marketing, as well as salaries, commissions and professional fees, increased to S\$2.4 million in 1Q FY2017 from S\$2.1 million in 1Q FY2016, primarily due to the new direct sales and boat brokerage models.

Other non-operating income decreased to S\$0.2 million in 1Q FY2017 from S\$0.7 million in 1Q FY2016, primarily due to lower foreign exchange gains.

The tax credit in 1Q FY2017 arose from the recognition of deferred tax assets of S\$0.2 million from unutilized tax losses and capital allowances of a subsidiary company.

As a result of the above, the Group recorded a net profit of S\$0.2 million in 1Q FY2017, compared to a net profit of S\$1.2 million in 1Q FY2016.

b) Any material factors that affected the cash flow, working capital, assets or liabilities of the group during the current financial period reported on.

The Group's cash flow from operations rose to \$\$3.5 million in 1Q FY2017 from \$\$1.4 million in 1Q FY2016, primarily due to lower working capital resulting from higher payables and lower receivables. The new orders secured in recent months led to more customer deposits and more purchases placed with vendors, which in turn led to increased payables. The decrease in receivables was due to the receipt of billings in FY2016.

Cash flows used in investing activities amounted to \$\$0.8 million in 1Q FY2017, due to the development of new yacht models as well as improvements to the Pasir Gudang facility, partially mitigated by proceeds from matured debt securities held-for-trading. In comparison, cash flows used in investing activities totaled \$\$1.4 million in 1Q FY2016.

Cash flows used in financing activities amounted to S\$0.5 million in 1Q FY2017, due to the repayment of loans used to partially finance the lease extension of the Group's yard in Pasir Gudang in FY2016. Cash flows used in financing activities were insignificant in 1Q FY2016.

As a result of the above, cash and cash equivalents rose to \$\$19.2 million as at 30 September 2016 from \$\$16.4 million as at 30 June 2016.

Non-current assets increased to \$\$29.6 million as at 30 September 2016 from \$\$29.1 million as at 30 June 2016 due to higher goodwill as a result of foreign exchange rate fluctuations and recognition of deferred tax assets. Current assets increased to \$\$38.0 million as at 30 September 2016 from \$\$36.0 million as at 30 June 2016 due to an increase in cash and cash equivalents as explained as well as higher prepayments. This was partially offset by a decrease in receivables.

Total liabilities increased to S\$22.0 million as at 30 September 2016 from S\$19.6 million as at 30 June 2016 mainly due to the increase in payables.

10. A commentary at the date of the announcement of the competitive conditions of the industry in which the group operates and any known factors or events that may affect the group in the next reporting period and the next 12 months.

The Group will focus on improving production in the next 12 months, having successfully integrated the operations of its two brands – Grand Banks and Palm Beach – over the past two years. The Group will continue to tap mature markets such as U.S., Europe and Australia to grow its order book, while exploring growth opportunities in Asia. It will also look into the development of more boat designs.

The Group received six new boat orders in 1Q FY2017, lifting its aggregate net order book to \$\$36.8 million as at 30 September 2016, compared to \$\$34.1 million as at 30 June 2016. The launch of the Group's new boat models – Grand Banks 60, Eastbay 44 and 52, and Palm Beach 42 – in FY2017, in tandem with the factory-direct sales model, is expected to further raise the profile of its brands.

With its Australia facility operating at full capacity, the Group has been using its Malaysia yard to meet certain orders for Palm Beach boats. As previously disclosed, the lease for the Pasir Gudang facility in Malaysia has been extended to 2052, enabling the Group to continue operating in Johor for many more years. Based on current manpower resources, the yards in Australia and Malaysia will be running more efficiently by the end of FY2017. The Group will continue to improve operational efficiencies through automation and better production techniques such as robotic cutting and milling.

The Group will continue to monitor volatility in foreign exchange rates, particularly movements of the Malaysian Ringgit ("RM") and Australian dollar ("AUD") against the U.S. dollar ("USD") and the RM against AUD. The Group's revenues are denominated in USD and AUD, while its manufacturing facilities are located in Malaysia and Australia.

The transaction has been reviewed by the Risk Management & Audit Committee ("RMAC") of the Company, and the RMAC is of the view that the terms of the transaction is on normal commercial terms, and is not prejudicial to the interest of the Company and its minority shareholders.
